Art Lesson Plan

Lesson: Fruit Project

Objectives: Student is to complete a 6" X 6" painting of one item of fruit

Materials: 6" X 6" Canvas, Paint, Brushes

Focus/Model: Del Monte Fruit and Scott Guelcher's Fruit Paintings.

Vocabulary: Texture, Still Life, Canvas, Stretcher Bars, Acrylic

Procedure: Student is to create a full color painting of one item of fruit with acrylic paint on a 6" X 6" canvas with an abstract background with texture as shown by example.

Evaluation: Did the student show an understanding of the artistic concepts taught? Did the student use time and materials wisely? Did the student follow directions and guidelines? Did the student create a piece of artwork of fruit?

ESOL Strategies: Realia, cooperative learning, audio visual, music, total physical response, activating background knowledge, K/W/L, non-verbal communication, multi-sensory approach, direct instruction.
