Art Lesson Plan

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Lesson: One Point Perspective Project

<u>Objectives:</u> Student is to complete a cityscape using proper one point perspective. Create a composition that is interesting and appealing. Student is to use all artistic techniques correctly. Student is to follow all directions and guidelines.

Materials: Paper, Pencil, Ruler, Colored Pencils

<u>Focus/Model:</u> Richard Estes artwork along with other artists works and photographs of cities.

Vocabulary: Vanishing Point. Askew, Perspective, Horizon Line

<u>Procedure:</u> Start by drawing your composition in pencil so that you can erase all the extra lines that are drawn due to using perspective. Second you want to make sure everything is outlined properly. Last you want to color the entire picture so that you end up with a final product.

<u>Evaluation</u>: Did the student show an understanding of the artistic concepts taught? Did the student use time and materials wisely? Did the student follow directions and the guidelines? Did the student create a piece of artwork of relevance?
