

Art Lesson Plan

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Lesson: Pocket Drawing

Objectives: To create a unique composition of the items in your pocket.

Materials: Paper, Pencil, Drawing Materials

Focus/Model: Keys

Vocabulary: Shading, Composition, Angle, Grade, Illusion

Procedure: Using the items in your pocket arrange a composition that is pleasing and make a drawing. Repeat items if necessary.

Evaluation: Did the student show an understanding of the artistic concepts taught? Did the student use time and materials wisely? Did the student follow directions and the guidelines? Did the student create a piece of artwork of personal value?

ESOL Strategies: Realia, cooperative learning, audio visual, music, total physical response, activating background knowledge, K/W/L, non-verbal communication, multi-sensory approach, direct instruction.
