Art Lesson Plan

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Lesson: Scientific Illustration

<u>Objectives:</u> Create a scientific illustration in the style of Leonardo Da Vinci of either the human anatomy or your own original invention.

Materials: Manilla Paper, Pencils, Charcoal

Focus/Model: Leonardo Da Vinci's Sketchbooks

<u>Vocabulary:</u> Renaissance, Anatomical, Fresco, Madonna, Mannerism

<u>Procedure:</u> Students will begin to sketch an idea of either a scientific illustration of anatomy or a unique invention. They will then transfer that design onto the manila paper then go over it with charcoal.

Evaluation: Did the student show an understanding of the artistic concepts taught? Did the student use time and materials wisely? Did the student follow directions and the guidelines? Did the student create a piece of artwork of personal issue or action?

ESOL Strategies: Realia, cooperative learning, audio visual, music, total physical response, activating background knowledge, K/W/L, non-verbal communication, multi-sensory approach, direct instruction.
