Lesson: Surrealism Project

<u>Objectives:</u> Student is to complete a drawing of the five items chosen from the box. The drawing should be "dreamlike" or "surrealism". Student is to use all artistic techniques correctly. Student is to follow all directions and guidelines for the Project.

Materials: Drawing Paper, Pencil, Colored Pencils, Markers

Focus/Model: Multiple works from Salvador Dali and past student works.

Vocabulary: Surrealism, Visions, Juxtaposition, Dada, Symbolism

<u>Procedure:</u> Student is to design and create a full color Surrealist from the five objects picked out of the box. Student is to visualize a dreamlike environment for this piece of art. Student's artwork must include the five items but may include others also. Must be a full color drawing and the size must be 18" X 12"

Evaluation: Did the student show an understanding of the artistic concepts taught? Did the student use time and materials wisely? Did the student follow directions and guidelines? Did the student create a piece of artwork of personal significance?

ESOL Strategies: Realia, cooperative learning, audio visual, music, total physical response, activating background knowledge, K/W/L, non-verbal communication, multi-sensory approach, direct instruction.
