## Art Lesson Plan

Lesson: Watercolor Pop Art Product

**Objectives:** Student is to complete a watercolor painting of a product of their choice.

Materials: Paper, Pencil, Sharpie, watercolor paint

Focus/Model: Andy Warhol, Product designs

Vocabulary: Pop Art, Product, Marketing, Graphic Design

**Procedure:** Start by drawing your composition in pencil so that you can erase all the extra lines that are not to be painted. Your composition should include the product of your choice and along with a interesting design for the background. Next you should complete your painting by using the watercolor to color your picture. Once dry go over all the lines with black Sharpie.

**Evaluation**: Did the student show an understanding of the artistic concepts taught? Did the student use time and materials wisely? Did the student follow directions and the guidelines? Did the student create a piece of artwork of relevance?
